The objective of this program is to provide students with a foundation standard of knowledge, skills and values in key subject area of Accounting. The program will provide exit points for students not wishing to proceed to diploma level of knowledge, skills and values in key subject area of Accounting.

Admissions Requirements

Completion of (at least) a 3 year degree program, or 3-year tertiary Diploma at an agreed standard, or equivalent from a recognised university.

Required proficiency in English: IELTS overall band score of 6.0 with no band less than 6.0 TOEFL Paper 550 (TWE 4.0), TOEFL Computer 213 TOEFL iBT 79-80 with minimum of 13-Reading, 12-Listening, 18-Speaking, 21-Writing., Pearson 50 (no band score less than 50) and Cambridge 52 with no less than borderline in each skill.

Program overview & objectives

The Graduate Diploma of Professional Accounting has been developed as both an entry point and an exit point for the Master of Professional Accounting.

The objective of this program is to provide students with an intermediate standard of knowledge, skills and values in key subject area of Accounting. The program will provide an exit point for students not wishing proceed to Masters level in the area of Accounting.

Admissions Requirements

Applicants should hold a Bachelor degree or equivalent professional qualification. Applicants holding other academic or professional qualifications and/or with no work experience may also be granted admission to the program following an evaluation of their academic and professional skills. Professional qualification and work experience will be assessed by faculty Program Coordinator

Applicants would be presumed to have proficiency in using a computer, including common office automation software such as spread sheets and word processing programs. Where such proficiency is not held, applicants would be required to undertake a preparatory program which would be additional to GDPA program requirements.

Required proficiency in English: IELTS overall band score of 6.0 with no band less than 6.0 TOEFL Paper 550 (TWE 4.0), TOEFL Computer 213 TOEFL iBT 60-79 with minimum of 13-Reading, 12-Listening, 18-Speaking, 21-Writing. Pearson 50 (no band score less than 50) and Cambridge 52 with no less than borderline in each skill.
